All Grand, first, and second place winners in the Senior Division are invited to participate in the Michigan Science and Engineering Fair, Saturday, April 9, 2005 at Kettering University. Your \$40 entry fee for the MSEF will be paid by the Science and Engineering Fair of Metropolitan Detroit so you are strongly encouraged to participate!

Why should you enter the MSEF?? You've already done the work, so you might as well reap some more benefits! A new set of judges will evaluate the projects and you will have opportunities to win more awards, savings bonds, and scholarships. Two overall winners at the state fair will be chosen to attend the International Science and Engineering Fair in Phoenix, AZ from May 8-13, 2005. If you already have a trip to the ISEF and win top honors at the MSEF, SEFMD will be able to send an additional person to the ISEF. SEFMD Grand Award winners selected to attend the ISEF should DEFINITELY attend to gain experience to the actual judging process that will be used at the ISEF. In addition, Kettering is awarding \$80,000 in scholarships to the top winners.

What do you need to do to enter? You need to complete the attached response form and either fax it to us by **Friday, March 18** to 248-479-0383 (fax number) OR email the information requested to sf2005@sefmd.org. Be sure to indicate if you will be providing your own transportation or if you would like to ride a bus departing from Mercy High School in Farmington that day. *All* students, entering the MSEF or not, need to return this form. **Late responses will not be considered for the MSEF.**

What do you need to bring on Saturday, April 9? You will need to bring your project with you on judging day. Lunch will be provided by Kettering University.
