Dear Fair Director:

This year, the Statewide Science and Engineering Fair will be held at Kettering University in Flint, MI on SATURDAY, April 8, 2006 In addition to the normal awards presented at the state science fair, Kettering University will also be awarding FOUR \$20,000 scholarships (\$5,000 per year for 4 years) or a total of \$80,000 for the top winners!

Please review the affiliation agreement attached. Complete the form and attach the supporting documents required and submit your reservation payment by April 3, 2006.

Because of the late date of the state fair (it is actually AFTER the last allowable date of a fair) and to comply with the special requirements for Science Service (to permit us to have the fair after their deadline), there are a few additional requirements when you attend the state science fair.

- 1) Make sure you have identified TWO alternates from your local fair to attend the International Science fair (should the top one or two students from the state be from your fair). You should have the parental release forms completed (for your alternates) and be prepared to do a lot of 'quick juggling' You will need to have all their paperwork with you at the state fair. We will scan the information into the system, email it to Science Service, and then actually fly the results/paperwork to them that night!
- 2) Make certain that ALL the paperwork (regarding SRC approvals at the local fair) for all of your students is accurate and correct. Bring the original of all this paperwork with you to the state fair.

This year, we have again secured a block of hotel reservations See the attached information sheet to determine if you want to make use of any of this packages. Deadline is April 3, 2006.

Lastly, we have re-written the state science fair web site.
